

Trenton Falls, Oct 1st 1952

The Ross Township Council met on the above date, and all members were present. Minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed by the Reeve. Bills & Communications were read and considered.

Reeve Wallace reported, interviewing the Reeve of Horton, on re-raising of Government road on 8 Concession, which passes through the Township of Horton. Reeve Jamieson of Horton agreed to give the matter consideration.

The spending of the balance of Colonization Maintenance Road Money was discussed. Council then adjourned for one hour lunch.

On re-assembling, Councillors Curry and Seton reported interviewing Mr. John Robinson & Mr. John H. Byce re parcel road through concession 9, Lot 3. and were able to make a satisfactory settlement.

Reeve Wallace and Councillor Jeffrey reported examining ~~to~~ award ditch between concessions 5 & 6 through lots 8 & 9, and found the same to be in an unsatisfactory condition. Upon an examination of the law in regard to the matter, it was found to be a case for the Civil Engineers and not for the Council.

After further discussion re the spending of Maintenance road money, it was moved by Thos. Jeffrey, seconded by John Wilson that John Seton be given \$250⁰⁰ to spend on Queen's Line

roads, and L. Curry be given \$50⁰⁰ to spend on Government Road leading to Postage Du Fort. Carried.

The following Bills and Accts. were passed and orders drawn on the Treasurer in payment thereof. — Clifford Thompson, repairing bridge, cutting trees & brush \$2⁰⁰; Jas. Oates, cutting weeds on sidewalk \$1⁰⁰; John McGill repairing bridge \$15⁵⁰; Charles Kollschmitt gravel \$45⁰⁰; Labt. Jones, Cobden, spike nails per John Code 25⁰⁰; Albert Sutton dragging road \$5¹⁰; Rev. A. E. Winter refund on dog tax \$2⁰⁰; H. A. Parr, drugs \$25⁰⁰; E. B. Bulmer, postage and excise stamps \$35⁶⁰.

Council then adjourned to meet the 1st Saturday in November.
