After the nomination meeting held this day W. Wallace called the Councillors together to decide on some matters which had come up, and which needed immediate attention. All councillors present except Councillor Wilson.

The Clerk was instructed to write the Board of Railway Commissioners, objecting to the C. P. Railway lifting the cattle guards on the Right of Way where highways throughout the Township cross the said Railway.

A Committee composed of Councillors Ineson and Curay were appointed as a Relief Committee to look after the destitute throughout the Township.

The Treasurer was ordered to pay Balance of Money owing to the Schools, also to pay to the County Treasurer, balance owing the County for the year 1931 with interest, also on the County rate for 1932 an amount which he, the Treasurer, considered the collection of taxes up to the present time would allow.
