

Foresters Falls Jan. 9th 1933 1

The first regular meeting of the Council of the Township of Ross. for the year 1933 was held on the above date. Present. Reeve Albert Wallace, Councillors John Dretton; Thos Jeffrey, & Laughlin Curry. After each had made his declaration of office before the Clerk the minutes of last regular meeting also special meeting held Dec. 26/1932 were read, approved and signed.

A number of communications, bills and Accts were presented and considered.

Mr. Curry gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of holding another nomination meeting (also an election if necessary) to fill the vacancy on the Council board, caused by the failure of Mr. John Wilson, who was nominated on Dec. 24/32 but who failed to qualify.

Mr. Dretton gave notice, to introduce a By-Law to authorize and provide for the payment of all salaries, bills and accounts, and all other necessary expenditures for the present year.

Mr. Jeffrey gave notice, to introduce a By-Law to provide for the appointment of all township officers for the present year.

Council then adjourned for 1 hour.

On reassembling Mr. Curry introduced By-Law No 478 of which he had given notice, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jeffrey, was read a first time.

Mr. Dretton introduced By-Law (No 479) of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Curry was read a first time.

Mr. Jeffrey introduced By-Law 480 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Dretton was read a first time.
