

Forester Falls May 6/1933

Regular meeting of Ross Council on the above date, all members present. Minutes of last regular meeting, also minutes of special meeting held at C. B. Bulmer's Residence on April 27/33 were read, adopted and signed.

Mr Hugh Logan and Ed. Gibson came before the Council asking repairs be done on road leading to and around Logans Lake.

The Council authorized them to grade it up at the present time, as that road was drafted into the Golden Road By-Law to be repaired during coming summer.

A deputation from Beadling, Algie Davidson, Clerk-Treasurer, Harris Brown, and John Cowie, waited on the Council soliciting a grant to the North Renfrew Agri. Society.

Mr Davidson also asked that he be given Township Road Insurance this year.

Bills and Communications were then read and considered.

Council then adjourned for 1 hour.

On re-assembling Mr. Frank McIntyre waited on the Council re. Road Insurance.

After considerable discussion it was moved by J. Curry and seconded by P. A. Fraser that Mr F. McIntyre be given the road insurance for this year. Carried.
