

Forester's Falls Ont.

October 7, 1933

The meeting of the House Council was held in the Orange Hall at Forester's Falls on the above date with all members present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read. The clerk had been informed by the Secretary-Treasurer of School Section No 8, that an error had been made in the amount of the requisition made by that section. It was moved by Thos. Jeffrey seconded by R. A. Fraser that the rate mentioned in By Law No 483 regards said section to be changed to read 2.7 mills instead of 8 mills. The change being made the minutes were then approved as <sup>then</sup> read and signed by the Clerk.

The bills and communications were read and considered.

The council then adjourned for one hour for dinner.

On reassembling Councillors Cruton and Curry gave the report on their inspection of the Guard Ditch opposite Lots 8 and 9 between Concessions 5 and 6. The report said the work was progressing favourably except <sup>part</sup> opposite Lot 8. In the said report's motion the clerk was instructed to notify Lindsay Wallace, owner of part of Lot 8, to have his share of said Ditch cleaned out before Nov. 1, 1933 and should the work not be done on or before said date the council would take necessary steps to have the work performed. The report was accepted.

Councillor Curry's report on the financial circumstances of Mrs. Wom Coffey said she was entitled to assistance from the Council. Her name



was placed on the Relief List.
