The members of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross, met according to Statute on the above date; all members present. Reeve Albert Wallace, Councillor John Dretton; Thos Jeffrey; Robt. A Fraser; and James Bruce.

After each had made his Declaration of Office before the Clerk, the minutes of the last meeting were read approved and signed by the Reeve.

A number of Bills and Communications were read and considered.

Mr. Fraser gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the Appointment of 9wp. Officers for the year 1934.

Mr. Bruce gave notice that he would introduce a By-Law to authorize and provide for the payment of all salaries, Bills, and accounts, and all other necessary expenditures for the present year.

Mr. Dretton gave notice of a By-Law to authorize and provide for the construction and improvement of main and leading roads within the Township, subject to the provisions of the Colonization Roads By-Law.

Council then adjourned for one hour for dinner.
