Mr. W. A. Cook. Benfrew came before the Council soliciting Twp Road Insurance for year 1934.

Bills and Communications were then read and considered.

Mr. Ireton gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law authorizing the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow from Bank of Montreal, a sum not to exceed \$3000. to meet current expenditures.

Moved by Geo. Jeffrey seconded by Jas. Bruce that Mr. Simpson be given Road Insurance. Carried.

Mr. Ireton then introduced By-Law No. 489. of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Fraser was read a first time.

On motion of Jeffrey and Bruce By-Law 489. was read a second and third time short and finally passed.

The Ross Council met as a court  
 of Revision in the Grange Hall  
 at Foresters Falls at 9 o'clock. A.M.  
 on the above date, to hear the  
 several appeals against assessment  
 and also for general revision of  
 assessment Roll for year 1934.  
 All the members present. After  
 each member had subscribed to the  
 oath of the court, Mr. A. Wallace  
 was appointed chairman.

Only four appeals against their  
 assessment came before the Court.  
 The Canadian National Railways having  
 previously withdrawn their appeal.  
 Two of the appeals heard were Mr. John  
 Pettigrew, F. Falls, and Mrs. Wm. Ledgerwood,  
 Arnprior. The assessment of both of  
 these were sustained. Of the other  
 two appeals, Mr. Jas. Strahan's assess-  
 ment was reduced \$100 and Mr. Wm.  
 Dunningan's assessment was reduced  
 \$50.
