The Ross Council met according to adjournment on the above date.

All members present. Minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed by the Reeve.

Bill and Communications were then read and considered.

Mr. Bruce gave notice of a By-Law to borrow by way of note a sum of Money from the Bank to credit the Good Roads account with the County.

The meeting then adjourned for dinner. On reassembling Mr. Bruce introduced By-Law No 496, of which he had given notice, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Fraser that the blank in By-Law be filled in with the sum of \$5,000⁰⁰ and be read a first time.

On Motion of Mr. Ineson seconded by Mr. Jeffrey By-Law No 496 was read a second and third time short and finally passed.

A letter was received from the Division Engineer, Barry's Bay informing the Council of the approval by the Minister of Northern Development of By-Law No. 495 for the expenditure of \$3000⁰⁰ under Colonization Roads Act, all to be spent on Maintenance of Township Roads.
