Colonization Road by Law No 495 was introduced and on motion of Mr. Jeffrey seconded by Mr. Chase was read a third time and finally passed. The Reeve and the Clerk then signed the by-law.

Moved by John Breton seconded by P. A. Chase that the rate of wages for the season be as follows: overseers 28 cts per hour laborer 20 cts per hour, and team and teamster be 40 cts per hour, carried.
