 requisition asking the  
 Council to raise by way  
 of Debentures upon the  
 taxable property of this  
 section the sum of \$5500.  
 for building and equipping  
 for an addition to the present  
 school building and for  
 the installation of low pressure  
 steam heating system  
 suitable for heating the present  
 school and the addition.

The Council then adjourned  
 for one hour dinner.

On reassembling Mr.  
 Bruce gave notice that he  
 would at this meeting of  
 Council introduce a  
 by-law No. 4 & 7 to raise by  
 way of loan the sum of  
 \$5000 for the erection and  
 equipping and necessary  
 alterations for an addition  
 to the present school  
 building in and for the  
 Public school section No. 6.  
 of the Township of Ross County
