The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met according to statute on the above date, with all members present.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted and signed by the Reeve. Bill and Communications were also read and considered.

Before the council adjourned for noon hour a committee consisting of Samuel Day; Henry Dittburner

and Jas. Jack appointed by the rate payers of the village of Foresters Falls, waited upon the Council, asking the Council to install and maintain electric lights upon the streets of the said village now since the hydro electric had entered the same. After considerable discussion the Council decided to take no action in the matter at the present time.

An evening assembly after noon hour. Mr. J. Dutton gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the appointment of Deputy returning officers and clerks for slipshod polling places in case there be a municipal election.

He then introduced a resolution (which was endorsed by the members of the Council) protesting against the activities of certain Mortgage Companies within the Municipality. The resolution to be forwarded to Hon. Duncan Marshall, Minister of Agriculture for Ontario.
