Bills and Communications were next considered. Mr. Bruce gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the levying of the necessary rates for the present year.

Council then adjourned for dinner. On re-assembling after dinner Messrs Stephen Gilmour and William McMillan waited upon the Council asking for a grant towards Hobden Agricultural Society.

Mr. Bruce introduced By-Law No. 506 for the purpose of levying

necessary rates for the year 1936 and on his motion seconded by Mr. Dutton was read a first time. On motion of Mr. Jeffrey seconded by Mr. Baker, the blanks in By-Law No. 506 were filled in as follows and read a second time. County rate 21 mills. Township rate 4 mills.
