Forester's Falls, Dec. 15/36

The Municipal Council
met at Forester's Falls, according
to Statutes on the above date.
The Reeve in the chair and all
members present. Minutes
of previous meeting were read,
adopted and signed by the
Reeve. Bills and Communication
were next read and considered.
Mr. Jas. Bruce gave notice
that he would at this meeting
of Council introduce a By-Law
to appoint Returning
Officers, Deputy Returning
Officers and Poll clerks, for
the different Polling sub-divis-
ions, in case there be a neglect
for Councilors for the coming
year.

Council then adjourned for dinner.
On reassembling the By-Law
as submitted by the Bell Telephone
Co. asking for the privilege to
reconstruct their lines between
Concession 1 + 2 from lots 18^{and 19}
and between Lots 20 and 21. Con-
cession 2 was passed, with the

appointment of Theodore Tuast as
the Township representative.

Mr. Bruce then introduced
By-Law No. 507, of which he had
given notice and on his motion,
seconded by John Iretan was read
a first time.

seconded by Thos. Jeffrey the blanks
in By-Law No. 507 were filled in
as follows and read second time;

On motion of John Iretan
seconded by R. A. Fraser, By-Law
No. 507 was read a third time
short and finally passed.

seconded by Jas. Bruce that the
treasure pay at present only one-
half the amount of monies
allotted to the different school
sections, the balance to be paid
when requested by the school
secretaries. Carried.
