

Foustus Falls, Jan 11th 1937

Municipal Council of the Township of Ross, met according to Statute on above date, all members present.

After each had subscribed to oath of office, and had taken their seats around the table, the minutes of last meeting of Council were read, approved of and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and Communications were next read and discussed.

Ed. D. Hill and Wm. Burton came before the Council, asking for a grant of money to be spent, on Forest Road, through Lots. 8, 9 & 10 Con 3. during the coming summer. The Council promised them consideration.

Council then adjourned one hour for dinner.
