

Foresters Falls. March 6 - 1937

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date, all Councillors with the exception of Mr. Jeffrey, present. The Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted and signed by the Reeve. Bills and communications were read and considered.

The clerk was instructed to write the Dept. of Municipal Affairs regarding a new application for the borrowing of moneys by debentures on behalf of S.S. No. 6.

Mr. Dutton gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By Law to authorize and provide for the construction and maintenance of roads within the Township subject to the provision of the Colonization Roads Act.

Mr. Wm. Stephens Jr. came before Council in connection with accident on Queen Line this winter.

Council then adjourned one hour for dinner.

On reassembling Mr. Dutton introduced By Law No. 511 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Bruce the blanks in the By Law were filled in with the sum of \$3000⁰⁰ and read a second time (carried).

It was moved by Mr. Fraser and seconded by Mr. Bruce that E. B. Ross be appointed Weed Inspector for the year 1937 at a salary of \$65⁰⁰ (carried).

Mr. Ed. Dittmer came before Council in connection with this year's assessment. Council referred him to the Court of Revision in June.

Mr. E. B. Bulmer came before Council in connection with S & S No. 6 Debentures.

Mr. Hugh Wilson having resigned the position of Treasurer, several applications were considered for the position.

Finally Mr. Richard Gould Sr. being given the preference. It was moved by Mr. Bruce seconded by Mr. Fraser that Richard Gould Sr. be appointed Treasurer at salary \$75⁰⁰ per year plus postage + stationery; and he duly authorized to sign cheques along with the Reeve on behalf of the Township (carried)
