

Foresters Falls. April 3/37

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date, at 10 o'clock, the Reeve and all members of Council, present.

Minutes of last meeting were read adopted and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and Communications were read and considered.

Mr. Dretton gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By-Law to rescind By-Law No. 497.

Mr. Bruce gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By-Law to replace By-Law No. 497.

Council adjourned one hour for lunch.

On reassembling Mr. Dretton introduced By-Law No. 512, repealing By-Law No. 497, passed in 1935, which had authorized the Township to borrow \$5500.00 by way of debentures on account of S.S. No. 6, and which had set the rate of interest at 4% and the length of the debenture payments as 20 years.

On Mr. Dretton's motion, seconded by Mr. Jeffrey By-Law No. 512 was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Fraser, seconded by Mr. Bruce By-Law No. 512 was read a second time and third time short and finally passed (carried).

Mr. Bruce introduced By-Law No. 513, a By-Law to raise by way of debentures the sum of \$5500.00 for the erection and necessary alterations, for an addition to the present school building in Foresters Falls, in and for the Public School Section No. 6 of the Township of Ross County of Renfrew. Setting the rate of interest at 5½% and the length of the debenture payments as 15 years.

On Mr. Bruce's motion seconded by Mr. Dretton By-Law No. 513 was read a first time.
