Saturday Nov. 6 - 1937.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 10 A.M. The Reeve and all Councillors present.

Minutes of last meeting were read, approved of, and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and Communications were read and considered.

The Clerk was instructed to write Jas. A. Wright, to the effect, that Council intended to commence work right away cleaning out their portion of Award Ditch, and if his share was not done on completion of Council's share, Council would do his lands, cost of same would be added in his taxes.

It was moved by Jas. Bruce seconded by R. A. Fraser that Council look after cleaning out of their respective portions of Award Ditch. (Carried)

It was moved by John Britton seconded by Thor. Jefferies that the Township become purchasers of lands that do not bring the full amount of Taxes and costs against them at the ensuing County Treasurer's adjourned Tax Sale of Lands in the County of Renfrew. (Carried)

The Clerk was instructed to give John A. Wilson one week to pay up past due rent to date, failing to do so by that date, he would be asked by the proper authorities to vacate.
