

Foresters Hall. Wed. Dec. 15 - 1937

The Municipal Corporation of the Township of Ross ^{according to Statute} met on the above date at 10. A.M. All members present.

Minutes of last meeting, were read, approved of and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and communications were read, ^{and considered} approved of, and signed by the Reeve.

Mr. Bruce gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By-Law to appoint Returning Officer, Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the different Polling Sub-Divisions, in the event of there being an election for Reeve and Councillors for the coming year.

It was moved by Mr. Jeffery seconded by Mr. Ireton that the Treasurer pay at present, only one half the amount of moneys due the different school sections, the balance to be paid when requested by the school Secretaries (carried)

Mrs. Ed. Wilson came before Council asking for more relief.

The clerk was instructed to write Miss Mallon, Pembroke, to find out what prospects Mrs. Wilson had of obtaining Mother's Allowance Pension

Mr. Bruce then introduced By-Law No. 516, of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Fraser was read a first time.
