

Dec. 27-37.

A special meeting of Council was held in the Orange Hall on the above date at 10. A. M. For the purpose of interviewing the Ratepayers of the Village of Foresters Falls, so that some agreeable arrangement might be made re Street Lighting. A goodly number of ratepayers attended.

Mr. Fraser gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By Law to authorize the Corporation to enter into an agreement with the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario for Street Lighting.

After some discussion between Council and ratepayers it was decided that the lights be installed, Council to pay half of the yearly cost and the other half to be levied yearly on the resident ratepayers in the Village Twelve Lights to be installed at a cost of Fourteen Dollars each.

Mr. Fraser then introduced By Law No. 517 of which he had given notice (re street lighting) and on his motion seconded by Mr. Ireton the By Law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Bruce seconded by Mr. Jeffery By Law No. 517 was read a second time, having the blanks filled in authorizing Council to levy 50% of the cost of street lighting on the resident Ratepayers in Foresters Falls, and the other fifty per cent on the Township as a whole.

On motion of Mr. Ireton seconded by Mr. Fraser By Law No. 517 was read a third time short and finally passed (Carried).
