

Monday Jan. 10 - 1938

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 11. A. M. All members present.

After each had subscribed to the customary oath and had taken their places about the table, the minutes of last meetings were read, approved of, and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and communications were read and considered:

Mr. Jeffery gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By-Law for the appointing of all Municipal Officers for the year 1938

Mr. Bruce gave notice of a By-Law to authorize and provide for the payment of all salaries, bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures for the year 1938

Mr. Dretton gave notice of a By-law to authorize and empower the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow on the credit of the Township by way of loan, money from the Bank of Nova Scotia Canada, a sum not to exceed \$5000.00 to meet the current expenditures of the Township during the present year

It was moved by R. A. Fraser seconded by James Bruce that the application of Edward Mayhew and Melvin Clarke, re auditing of the books of the Township for 1937, be accepted (Carried).

Mr. Jeffery then introduced By Law no 518 of which he had given notice, re appointing of 1938 Officers, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Dretton was read a first time

It was moved by R. A. Fraser seconded by Jas. Bruce that By Law no 518 have the blanks filled in as follows and be read a second time

The clerk was instructed to write Mrs. Elizabeth Rankin, Pembroke, to the effect, that she give Council conclusive Proof, why she should be exempt from Interest and Penalties on her tax arrears while her property in the Township was before the Board of Review.

Mr. Bruce then introduced By-Law no 519 of which he had given notice, re payment of salaries, bills and accounts, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jeffery was read a first time.

It was moved by John Dretton seconded by R. A. Fraser that By Law no 519 for the paying of all salaries, bills and accounts and all necessary expenditures of the present year, be now read a second and third time short, and passed, (Carried).

Mr. Dretton then introduced By Law no. 520 of which he had given notice, and on his motion seconded by R. A. Fraser the blanks in the By. Law were filled in with the sum of 5000⁰⁰ and read a first time.

It was moved by Thos. Jeffery seconded by Jas. Bruce that By. Law no. 520 be read a second and third time short and passed (Carried).

It was moved by Thos. Jeffery seconded by John Dretton, that the bookkeeper be given the printing and advt. for 1938 - Carried.
