Saturday Feb. 5 - 38.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 10 A.M. All members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read, approved of and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and Communications were read and considered.

Mr. Fraser gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By-Law to authorize and provide for the construction and maintenance of roads within the Township subject to the provision of the Colonization Roads Act.

It was moved by John Ireton seconded by James Bruce, that E. B. Ross be appointed Weed Inspector for the Township for 1938, at the usual salary (carried).

A proposal by the Dept. of Highway Municipal Roads Branch, that the Township come under the Highway Improvement Act, was turned down by Council, in favour of Statute Labor and Colonization.

Mr. Fraser then introduced by Law no 521 of which he had given notice and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Ireton was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Jeffery seconded by Mr. Bruce By-Law no. 521 was filled in with the sum of \$3000.00 maintenance and read a second time.

Messrs Edward Mayhew and Melvin Clarke came before Council in connection with Audit of the Township Books.

The Reeve was appointed to see a lawyer re licensing of slot machines in the Township.

The Clerk was instructed to write Allen McMullen to the effect that he would be given consideration, re spending of a sum of money on road mentioned in his letter.
