The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 10. A.M. All members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read, approved of, and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and communications were read and considered.

Mr. Archie Hawthorne came before Council, asking that Council aid him in building a wire fence along his farm on County Road to Foresters Falls. The Reeve promised to take the matter up with the Good Roads Committee of County Council.

Mr. Geo. Bingham came before Council asking that his name be removed from the Path Master List of the Township.

The Clerk was instructed to order a set of the new 1937 Revised Statutes of Ontario.

Correspondence was tabled between the Township and the Deputy Minister of Highways Toronto. Relative to the matter of the Township coming under the Highway Improvement Act, and abolishing Statute Labor.

The Reeve was instructed to take the matter up further with the Department as Council desired to stay under our present system of Colonization and Statute Labor.

An Audit of the Township Books having been made by Messrs. Mayhew and Clarke a copy of same was presented to Council under By-Law No 519. The following Bills and Accounts were passed and orders drawn on the Treasurer for same.
