

Foresters Falls.

Saturday April 2 - 1938.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 10.A.M. All Members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read, approved of, and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and Communications were read and considered.

It was moved by R.A. Fraser seconded by Jas. Bruce, that the Auditors Report as presented at the March meeting be adopted, and an abstract copy of same be published. (Carried).

Mr. Bruce gave notice of a By-law, to abolish Statute Labor in the Township.

Mr. Dretton gave notice of a By Law to provide for the total 1938 expenditure on Roads ^{in the Township} under the Highway Improvement Act.

Mr. Jeffrey gave notice of a By-law to appoint a Road Superintendent for the Township for 1938.

A Delegation representing the Ratepayers of U.S.S. No. 10. Ross. called upon Council in connection with Education Cents paid by them in their 1937 taxes.

Council agreed to consider the matter, and if it was found anything could be done to lighten their taxes, same would be attended to.

Mr. Wendell Collins came before Council asking for aid in building Road Fence.

Council took no definite action, but promised to find out the price of wire, and to let him know later what proposition they would make to him.

Mr. Bruce then introduced By-Law No. 522, of which he had given notice, re abolishing of Statute Labor, under section 6, Chap. 239 R.S.O. 1927, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Fraser was read a first time.

An motion of Mr. Dretton seconded by Mr. Jeffrey By-Law No. 522 was read a second and third time short and finally passed (Carried)

Mr. Dretton then introduced by Law No. 523 of which he had given notice. re the Total expenditure on Roads and Bridges in the Township for 1938 under the Highway Improvement Act, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jeffrey was read a first time.

An motion of Mr. Fraser seconded by Mr. Dretton By-Law No. 523 was filed in with the sum of 5000⁰⁰ maintenance and read a second time.

An motion of Mr. Bruce seconded by Mr. Jeffrey By-Law No. 523 was read a third time short and finally passed.

Mr. Jeffrey then introduced By-Law No. 524, of which he had given notice, re appointing of a Road Superintendent for the Township for 1938, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Dretton the By-Law was read a first time.

An motion of Mr. Fraser seconded by Mr. Jeffrey By-Law No. 524 was filed in with the name of W. J. McMeida as Road Superintendent for the Township for 1938, salary at the rate of 60¢ per hour for such time as he might be employed, and read a second time.

An motion of Mr. Dretton seconded by Mr. Bruce By-Law No. 524 was read a third time short and finally passed (Carried)
