Saturday June 4 - 38

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 9. A. M. as a Court of Revision with all members present. After each member had subscribed to the oath, it was moved by Jas. Bruce, seconded by Thos. Jeffrey that the Reeve act as Chairman - Carried

Four appeals against assessment were dealt with as follows -

Of the above R. S. May was given a reduction on buildings of \$200.00. The remaining three were given no reduction.

Messrs. Clark Hill Allister Johnson and John P. Johnson came before the Court of Revision in connection with school taxes paid in U. S. S No 10. No action was taken by council.

The Roll was read over and after a few necessary changes were made, it was moved by John Dretow, seconded by Thos. Jeffrey that the roll as read, be the assessment Roll for 1938 - Carried
Council then adjourned

After the adjournment of Court Council proceeded with general business of the Township. The minutes of last meeting were read, approved of, and signed by the Reeve. Bills and communications were read and considered. Mr. Ed Gibson came before Council in connection with the buying of the C. F. Coulter estate. Mr. George Selguson and Walter Bender came before Council asking permission of Council, that the Fourth Line Telephone Company be given permission to erect a second line of poles from Iron Bridge

corner to Highway, along side Muskrat Lake line poles. Council referred them to the Ontario Municipal Board.

It was moved by R. A. Fraser seconded by John Dretow that F. J. Parish of Kemptonville be appointed Drainage Inspector for the Township - Carried.

Mr. Martin Shannon came before Council in connection with the buying back of property formerly owned by him and now owned by the Township through tax sale.

Council left the matter until a later meeting or until a tax deed would be obtained by the Clerk.

Mr. J. P. Howard Division Engineer over the Township Roads attended Council meeting. A road program of approximately \$4500.00 was taken up, this amount to be mostly expended by July 1st.
