The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 9.30 A.M.

All members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read found correct, and signed by the Reeve.

Bills and Communications were read and considered.

Mrs Ed. Shannon and Martin Shannon, also the Administrators of Annie New Estate appeared before Council in connection with the buying of Township property $w\frac{1}{2}$ Lot 26 Con 6.

After a lengthy discussion it was moved by R.A. Fraser seconded by John Dretton that above property be sold to Martin Shannon for \$600⁰⁰, the Township to pay half this amount, \$300⁰⁰, to Annie New Estate, in order to satisfy a certain mortgage. Shannon + Shannon to do legal writings free of charge. (Carried).

Messrs Alex Peever and Ed. Gibson interviewed Council re the buying of Char-Coulter Estate. After due consideration Council agreed to sell same for the sum of 118⁰⁰, with no taxes to be paid in 1928. Division of property to be arranged, at a later date between the buyers, Peever, and Gibson.

Messrs Harris Burns and Armaur Johnston came before Council asking aid in connection with expenses re fire fighting in their bush lots this summer, their claim being made that fire started on Road Allowance on Town Line Ross + Westmeath.

After some discussion Council agreed to pay account submitted.

Mr. Archie Hawthorne came to Council asking for grant to Beachburg fair.
