

Fauntler Falls. Thursday Dec 15/38.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10. A. M. All members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read, found correct, and signed by the Reeve.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. Fraser gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By Law to appoint Returning Officer Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the different Polling Subdivisions, in the event of there being an election for Reeve and Councillors for the coming year.

It was moved by Jas. Bruce seconded by Thos. Jeffery that the Treasurer pay at present only one half the amount of money due the different School sections, the balance to be paid when requested by the School Secretaries. (Carried)

Mr. Jas. Cole interceded Council re the rebate of May Tax for 1938 against W<sup>2</sup> Lot 25 Con 3. - No action was taken by Council.

Mr. Wm. Stephens Sr. came before Council asking that they rebate him his Int. + ~~Attaches~~ Penalties on Tax Arrears. While Council sympathized with him, no action was taken.

Messrs Jas. Jack and Lat Waite came before Council asking that two Hydro Lights be erected on side street Fauntler Falls, in their vicinity.

The Clerk was instructed to write Hydro Electric Power Com. Appropria re the matter before any definite action could be taken by Council.
