The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross held their inaugural meeting on above date at 11 A.M.

After each had subscribed to the customary oath and taken their seats, the minutes of last meeting were read, found correct and signed by the Reeve.

Communication and accounts were read and considered.

It was moved by R. A. Fraser seconded by James Bruce that the application of Messrs Mawdsley and Clarke be accepted to do auditing of the books of the Township for 1938 (Carried)

It was moved by Thos. Jeffery seconded by John Dutton that the Cobden Sun be given the printing and advertising for 1939 (Carried)

It was moved by John Dutton seconded by R. A. Fraser that we ask the Hydro Electric Power Com. to install two extra 100 watt lamps on side street in S. Falls as per map submitted, 50% of the cost of service to be paid by the residents in S. Falls area, the other 50% to be paid by the Township. (Carried)

Mr. Jas. Bruce gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By Law for the purpose of appointing Municipal Officers for the year 1939

Mr. Dutton gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By Law to borrow by way of loan money from the Bank of Nova Scotia bonded to meet the current expenditures of the year 1939.

Mr. Jeffery gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce

a By Law to authorize and provide for the payment of all salaries, bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures for the year 1939.
