

Foresters Falls.
Saturday Feb. 4/29

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M. All members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. Fraser gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By Law to authorize and provide for the construction and maintenance of the roads within the Township under the Highway Improvement Act.

Correspondence was received from Mr. N. Campbell, Inspector of Public Schools, in connection with Public School Sections in a Township uniting to form Township School Boards.

Discussion took place with regards to the decision of County Council to make Renfrew County a Restricted Area, as far as T. B. in Cattle is concerned.

No definite action was taken by Council.

Mr. Fraser then introduced By Law No. 534 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jeffery, was read a first time.

An motion of Mr. Dretor seconded by Mr. Bruce By Law No 534, was filled in with the sum of \$5000⁰⁰ and read a second time.

An motion of Mr. Jeffery, seconded by Mr. Fraser By Law No. 534 was read a third time short and passed (Carried)

It was moved by James Bruce seconded by R. A. Fraser that the Reeve vacate the Chair, and John Dretton act as chairman (carried).

A note of thanks was then tendered the Reeve, moved by Thos. Jeffery and seconded by R. A. Fraser. In their remarks, both

Councillors spoke of Mr. Wallace's untiring efforts on behalf of the Township and in County Councils. They also commented on the courteous and helpful manner in which he had conducted all Council meetings since becoming Reeve some nine years ago. They also congratulated Mr. Wallace on his election to the Office of Warden of the County for the present year.

Mr. Wallace thanked the Council for their kind words, stating that it was few Reeves who were given the privilege of sitting with the same Council year after year, as was the case in Ross.

Mr. Wallace also mentioned the fine qualities of the late Mr. W. J. Catter, a former Clerk who was Clerk for a short time after the Reeve had assumed office.

The Reeve then resumed the Chair.
