The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M. according to statute.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. Bruce gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law to appoint Returning Officer, Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the different polling sub-division, in the event of there being an election for Reeve and Councillors for 1940 or longer.
