The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross, met on above date at 10 A.M. All members present. Minutes of last meeting were read, found correct, and signed by the Reeve.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. Fraser gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By Law ~~to~~ authorize and provide for the construction and maintenance of roads in the Township under the Highway Improvement Act.

Mr. Jeffery gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a By Law to appoint a Road Superintendent for the Township under Highway Improvement Act.

It was moved by James Bruce seconded by R.A. Fraser that L.S. Curry be appointed Treasurer of Township at a salary of 95.⁰⁰ per annum, and be authorized to sign cheques along with the Reeve, on behalf of the Township (Carried)

It was moved by John Breton seconded by James Bruce that the Treasurer be authorized to sign for cancelled cheques at Bank, and to sign for verification of Bank Balances (Carried).

Mr. Fraser then introduced By Law No 540 of which he had given notice re Road expenditure for 1940, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jeffery, was read a first time.

On motion of John Breton seconded by James Bruce, By Law No 540 was filled in with the sum of 27800 maintenance

and 200⁰⁰, for superintendence; and read a second time.

On motion of Chas. Jeffery seconded by R.A. Fraser By Law no 540 was read a third time short and passed.

Mr. Jeffery then introduced by Law no 541, of which he had given notice re appointment of Road Superintendent for the Township under Highway Improvement Act, and on his motion seconded by John Deton the By Law was read a first time;

On motion of R.A. Fraser seconded by James Bruce by Law no 541, was filed in short the name of W. H. McQuillan as Road Superintendent, at rate of 60 per hour. and read a second time.

On motion of John Deton, seconded by Chas. Jeffery By Law no 541 was read a third time short and passed.
