

Foresters Falls.

Sat June 1, 1940

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 9.45 AM. as a Court of Revision. All members present. After each had subscribed to the usual oath it was moved by Thos Jeffrey seconded by John Chilton that the Reeve act as Chairman (Carried).

Five appeals against assessments were dealt with as follows.

Joe Buraczewski - Con 4 Lots 1 & 2/17 N. 1/2 18, \$200⁰⁰ reduction on building.

John Seliminen - Con 2 Lot 17 - 75⁰⁰/₁₀₀ reduction on land.

Louise Faught - Con 8 N. 1/2 Lot 10 no change

Reneil Collins - Con 1. Lot 6 \$500⁰⁰ reduction on land.

Sherry Osborne - Con 2 Lots 12, 3, \$50⁰⁰ reduction on land.

The roll was then read over and after a few necessary changes were made it was moved by James Bruce seconded by R. A. Fraser that the Roll as read be the assessment Roll for the Township of Ross for 1940 (Carried).

After adjournment by Court, Council proceeded with general business.

Minutes of last meeting were read, found correct and signed by the Reeve.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. Robt Little appeared before Council asking that he be relieved of dog tax. No action was taken.

Re. request of Ed. Quast that he be allowed to build on certain vacant land in the village of Haley Council decided to obtain legal advice before any decision be made.
