

Saturday March 1/41.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 a. m. All members of Council present. Minutes of last meeting were read, found correct, and signed by the Recorder.

Communications and accounts were read and considered. Auditors report for 1940 was received by Council. It was moved by R. A. Fraser seconded by James Bruce that auditors report be adopted and that clerk be instructed to have same published. (Carried).

Letter of resignation was received from Mr. E. B. Ross weed inspector of the township.

After discussion by Council clerk was instructed to advertise for the position of weed inspector for 1941. Applicants to state salary expected.

Re letter from Mr. R. W. Tarran with respect to the canvass of the school sections of the township for War Savings funds. The matter was left with the clerk to write each school section secretary to appoint canvassers.
