

Foresters Falls June 7<sup>th</sup> /41

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 9 A.M. as a Court of Revision. All members present.

After each had subscribed to the <sup>usual</sup> oath it was moved by Thomas Jeffrey and seconded by John Dretton that the Rev. act as <sup>Chairman</sup> ~~Chairman~~ <sup>Carried</sup>.

It was moved by James Bruce and seconded by Thomas Jeffrey that R. A. Fraser act as Secretary. <sup>Carried</sup>.

One appeal against assessment was dealt with that of Harry Osborne Village Lots #1: 2.3 Cor. 2. assessment sustained. Refund of dog tax to R. A. Fraser granted.

The roll was then read and after a few necessary changes were made it was moved by John Dretton and seconded by Jas Bruce that the roll as corrected be the assessment Roll of the Township of Ross for the year 1941 <sup>Carried</sup>.

After adjournment of Court Council proceeded with general business.

Communications were read and considered.

Mr Dretton gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By Law to appoint officers to fill vacancies of Clerk and Road Superintendent.

Samuel Murdock interviewed Council regarding valuation of sheep killed by dogs.

Applications for the offices of Clerk and Road Superintendent were then considered.

Mr Dretton then introduced By Law No. 547 of which he had given notice regarding the appointing of officers to fill vacancies of Clerk and Road Superintendent and on his motion seconded by Mr Bruce the By Law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr Jeffrey and seconded by Mr Dretton By Law # 547 was filled in with the following names. R. A. Fraser Clerk. <sup>Sal 250<sup>00</sup></sup> and Gerald Miller Road Superintendent <sup>Sal 600<sup>00</sup> but not to exceed 200<sup>00</sup></sup>.

It was moved by James Bruce and seconded by Mr Jeffrey that By Law # 547 be now read a third time short and passed. <sup>Carried</sup>.

R. A. Fraser tendered his resignation as

Councillor and upon its acceptance by Council was sworn into the office of Clerk.

Mr Campbell Public School inspector interviewed Council regarding the forming of Central Township Public School Boards. It was deemed advisable by Council that they acquire more information before taking any action.

Mr Edward Pettigrew and Robert Bennett interviewed Council re the cleaning of Award ditch between Concessions nos. 5 and 6. It was decided to notify interested parties to have this ditch cleaned on or before July 1st 1941

Moved by John Ineson and seconded by James Bruce that we apply for deeds of lands having become Township property.

Moved by Thomas Jeffrey and seconded by James Bruce that the Municipality of the Township of Ross purchase a 1000 Victory Bond carried.
