The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10.A.M.

Minutes of previous meeting were read, found correct and signed by the Reere.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. Adm. W. Robinson interviewed Council regarding a rebate on dog tax. Council decided that they could not comply with his wishes.

Mr. James Lode appeared before Council regarding sheep killed by dogs and was referred to the sheep valuator.

Mr. Percil Collins and Mr. Mac Kercher approached the Council regarding the petitioning of the Ontario Government to open an office in Colden for the sale of motor vehicle licenses. The Council heartily supported this petition.

By-Law # 549 regarding fixing of assessment of Dominion Magnesium Limited having been supported by the ratepayers on January 24th by a vote of 75 for the by law and seven against was given its third reading on motion of Mr. Gorton and sec. by Mr. Bruce. Carried.

Mr. Jeffrey gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to authorize and provide for the maintenance of roads in the Township under the Highway Improvement Act for the year 1942.

Report and Petition for subsidy from the Government of moneys expended for road improvement in the township for year 1941 amounting to 4689.73 was approved by Council and signed.

Dog By-law

After some discussion regarding sheep being killed by dogs, it was decided to offer a reward of five dollars, to any one, shooting dogs within this municipality which are found killing sheep.

Mr. Jeffrey then introduced By-Law # 552 of which he had given notice re expenditure on Township Roads for 1942 and upon his motion seconded by Mr. Bennett was given its

first reading.

On motion of Mrs. Eaton and seconded by Mr. Bruce
By-law # 552 was filled in with the sum of
\$200 for road Superintendent and 48⁰⁰ for maintenance
(\$500) given its second and third reading short
and passed.
