

Foresters Falls June 6th 1942

The municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 10 A.M. as a Court of Revision. All members present. After each had subscribed to the usual oath it was moved by James Bruce and seconded by Thomas Jeffrey that Albert Wallace act as chairman.

Mrs. Emerson and Harry Haley appeared in Court in connection with appeal of assessment on lot 6-7. Concession 3. owing to certain irregularities the Court was not able to deal with this appeal.

Return of dog tax charged in error was returned to Clifford Quill and Wesley Cherry.

The Roll was then read and after a few necessary changes had been made it was moved by John Dutton and seconded by James Bruce that the Roll as corrected be the assessment Roll of Township of Ross for the year 1942. Carried.

Moved by Thomas Jeffrey and seconded by Joseph Bennett that this Court of Revision do now adjourn sine die.

The Council then met for general business with all members present and the Reeve in the Chair.

Minutes of previous meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve.

Joseph Bennett reported dogs having been shot his sheep and as the dogs were known Council instructed the Clerk to write William Pittigrew and Wesley Cherry requesting them to destroy their dogs.

James Code and Samuel Murdock interviewed Council regarding valuing sheep of James Code which had been killed by dogs. Mr. Murdock was instructed by Council to value sheep and make a report on same.

Moved by John Dutton and seconded by John Bruce that the Clerk be instructed to order one sixfoot

Moved by Thos Jeffrey and seconded by James Bruce that the Clerk be instructed to write Chown and Chown of Kennew to the effect that the Township of Ross did not have any claim against the Right-of-Way of the C. P. R. spur line running through the property of Mrs Lydia McLaughlin. Under By-law # 551 the following accounts were passed and orders drawn on Treasurer for payment of same.
