A letter from Norman Logan asking the Council to build a cattle pass under road to lake ^{was constructed} After some discussion it was decided to inform Mr Logan that he could put in this pass at his own expense and maintain same in future. Pass and road grade to be done according to specification of Council.

The school Board of S. S. #13 Ross requested the Council to loan them \$575⁰⁰ to pay for drilling of well on school property. They were instructed by Council to fulfil requirements of Section 56 and 57 of Public School Act. and then present their request.

The Clerk was authorized to present a Bill of \$21.82 to Horton Township regarding repairs on Culvert on River road. Work ^{being} done by Ross Township.
