Minutes of previous meeting were read found correct and signed by the Clerk. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

It was moved by Mr. Sutton and seconded by Mr. Bruce that the Clerk and clerk be ^{authorised} ~~empowered~~ to sign resolutions and maps presented by the Canadian Pacific Railway regarding road crossings on spur line from Staley's to Magnesium plant.

Moved by Mr. Jeffrey and seconded by Mr. Bennett that the Township Council loan to the school Board of School Section #13 Ross the sum of \$400 same to bear interest at the rate of 5%. Half of said sum with interest - to be paid ^{Council met} December 1942 and balance December 1943. Money to be used in payment of drilling well on school property.

It was moved by Jas. Bruce and seconded by Thos. Jeffrey that we make a grant of \$50 to this association.
