

Foresters Falls, December 15<sup>th</sup> 1942.

The municipal Council of the Township of Ross.  
met on above date at 10 A.M.

All members present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve.

Communications and accounts were read and considered

Mr Bruce gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law for the purpose of appointing returning officers deputy returning officers and Poll clerks for the different Poling sub-<sup>to fill the office</sup> divisions in the event of there being an election ~~of~~ <sup>of</sup> Reeve and Councillors for the years of 1943 and 1944.

It was moved by Thomas Jeffrey and seconded by John Dutton that the Treasurer pay at present and when convenient only one half amounts of school moneys to each section balance to be paid when requested by school Secretaries (Carried)

A petition for Grant to Public Library was considered and on motion of Mr Bruce and Mr Bennett \$25.00 was granted.

The clerk was instructed to write Mr John Jack regarding rolling of road in his section after snow storms during the present winter.

Mr Bruce then introduced By-law No 555 of which he had given notice re appointing of Election officers and on his motion seconded by Mr Dutton the By-law was read a first time. On motion of Mr Bennett sec by Mr Jeffrey By-law <sup>#555</sup> was filled in as follows and read a second time.

The weed inspector reported to Council on his years work. He advised that some extra consideration should be given regarding the extermination of certain weeds. Council discussed the use of certain chemicals for weed eradication but no definite action was taken.

An application for the auditing of the Township books was received from Mr Hubert <sup>Proposed</sup> and <sup>postponed</sup> was discussed but appointment was ~~postponed~~ till the January meeting.
