

Forsters Falls March 6<sup>th</sup> 1943.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M.

All members present except Thos Jeffrey who was detained <sup>through</sup> ill health.

Minutes of previous meeting was read found correct and signed by the Revere. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

The auditor's report <sup>for 1942</sup> was presented and after some consideration upon motion of Mrs. Britton and Bruce was accepted.

Mrs. Robinson and Bilton interviewed Council re the impounding of Mr. Robinson's horses and were advised to seek legal advice elsewhere.

A request was made by Norman Hogan that he be permitted to redeem his farm which had become the property of the Township through arrears of taxes.

After some discussion it was agreed that Mr. Hogan could <sup>procure</sup> have a title to this land by paying all arrears of taxes and expenses.

A delegation of the school board of S. S. # 6 discussed with the Council the advisability of organizing a Township School Area but no action was taken.
