An appeal against dog tax by James Goss was granted. The Roll was then read over and after the necessary changes had been made it was moved by Thos Jeffrey and seconded by Jas. Bennett that the Roll as corrected be the assessment Roll for the Township of Ross for the year 1943. Carried.
