

Foresters Falls April 1st / 1944

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date at 10 A.M.
All members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read found correct and signed by the Rec. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Having received an application by Archie Paver for the filling of the office of Road Superintendant it was moved by John Dutton seconded by Mr Jeffrey that the application be accepted.

A ~~request~~ from the Canadian Pacific Railway that the Council permit them to remove Cattle guards from crossings within the township was granted.

After carefully examining the Auditor's report it was moved by Mr Bennett and seconded by Mr Bruce that ^{this report} be accepted.

Moved by Mr Jeffrey seconded by Mr Bruce that the Balance of School money owing be paid at this meeting.

The Provincial Government having amended the Tilt Drainage Act whereby they reduce the rate of interest from four to three percent on debentures purchased by the Government

It was moved by Mr Bennett seconded by Mr Dutton that the interest rate on Tilt Drainage debentures within the Township be reduced to three percent.
