Mrs Lane Waite appeared before Council asking that the Council ~~grant her~~ to have a street light erected at the gate entrance to their farm property. This was considered but deemed not in the interest of the majority of the rate payers at the present time.

Mrs Ira Keyce approached Council regarding wire fence ~~bonus~~ ^{regarding} 80 rods wire fence erected along ~~Ross~~ ^{Township} Road. Payment was deferred till ~~the~~ ^{the} fence was cleaned away.
