

Foresters Falls Dec 15th / 1944

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M.

All members present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read found correct and signed by the Clerk. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. Bennett gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the purpose of appointing returning officer deputy returning officers and poll clerks for the different polling sub-divisions in the event of there being an election to fill the offices of Reeve and Councillors for the year 1945.

Rev. Mr. Hawley appeared before Council with Hydro Contract asking that they might be signed so that the Standard Church and Parsonage at Foresters Falls might be lighted. This was granted.

Mr. Gus Schrader interviewed Council regarding Taxes.

Mr. Ullsine approached Council as regard to keeping of Winter road opened on East side of ^{Highway} Lake and Town line between Ross & Westford.

As Error in assessment of Property in the East of Harry Bittles sold to Alex Davidson.

A delegation headed by Leslie Collins presented a resolution to Connection with The Canadian Federation of Agriculture.

They asked in this resolution that the Township Council would give a grant of \$1.00 per bona fide Farmer which would make each farmer a member of the Federation. This was discussed by the Council but no action was taken.

A petition for a grant to Foresters Falls Public Library was considered and upon motion of Mr. Bruce see by Mr. Jeffrey the sum of \$25.00 was granted.

The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. J. Liborn regarding contracts of Road Snowploughing and subsidy on same.

Moved by Mr Dutton see by Mr Jeffrey that the Treasurer be authorized to pay all of school shopkeeper's balance to be paid early in 1945. 273

Mr Bennett then introduced By-Law # 568 of which he had given notice re the appointment of election officers and on his motion seconded by Mr Dutton the Bylaw was read a first-time. On motion of Mr Bruce see by Mr Jeffrey
