

Foresters Falls February 3rd 1945

The Municipal Council of the Township of Foresters Falls met on above date at 10 A.M. with all members present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr John Murdock interviewed Council re the erection of a street light at the corner of Harriet and Elizabeth streets. After considerable discussion re this and previous requests for street lights it was moved by Jos Bennett and seconded by Fred Ross that we ^{make application} apply to the Hydro Commission for the erection of four additional street lights in the village of F. Falls.

The office of Sanitary Inspector being vacant it was moved by Ira Pyce seconded by Wm Hegarty that John Heron be appointed to fill this office for the year 1945

Moved by Fred Ross seconded by Jos Bennett that we authorize the Bank of Nova Scotia Cobden to pay all Township Debentures coming due in 1945.

Upon motion of Jos. Bennett seconded by Ira Pyce a By-law. was enacted to provide for the expenditures of moneys on Township Roads and Bridges during the year 1945 and copies of this By-law. be submitted to the Department of Highways for their approval.
