

Foresters Falls Sept 1 / 45.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M. with all members present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read found correct and signed by the Rev. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

A petition from the North Keeweenaw Agricultural Society asking for the usual grant was received and upon motion of Mr. Ross seconded by Mr. Byce a donation of \$50.00 was granted.

Mr. Leslie Collins appeared before Council in the interests of the Federation of Agriculture and presented a petition signed by forty farm ratepayers asking that the Council assess all farm property $\frac{1}{16}$ of a mill for Federation purposes.

Mr. Robert Bennett appeared before Council assuring them that the award ditch had been cleaned out and was now in first class condition.

Mr. Hegarty gave notice that he would introduce a By-law at this meeting of Council for the purpose of striking a levy of $\frac{1}{16}$ of a mill on all farm properties to support the Federation of Agriculture.

On motion of Mr. Hegarty seconded by Mr. Byce the By-law ^{no 574} was given its first and second reading and upon motion of Mr. Ross Sec. by Mr. Bennett was given its third reading and finally passed.

The subject of financing gifts for soldiers and a memorial for those who had paid the supreme sacrifice in World War II came up for discussion. After considerable debating it was moved by Mr. Bennett and seconded by Mr. Byce that we levy a 2 mill rate for three years to provide a fund for this purpose.

Mr. Bennett gave notice that he would introduce a By-law at this meeting

for the purpose of striking a levy of 2 mills to create a fund for soldiers gifts and memorial. Mr Bennett introduced By Law # 575 of which he had given notice and upon his motion seconded by Mr Ross it was given its first and second readings. Upon motion of Mr Hegarty sec by Mr Byce By Law # 575 was given its third reading and finally passed.

Moved by Mr Byce seconded by Mr Ross that the Road Superintendent make application for the statutory grant on a road expenditure of 4964.80 under By Law # 569 the following accounts were passed and orders drawn on treasurer for payment of same.
