

Foresters Falls October 6th / 1945

The municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date. at 10 A.M.

Members present were Councillors Bennett, Ross and Hegarty.

On motion of Mr Ross Sec by Mr Hegarty Mr Bennett was appointed Revere pro-tem and authorized to sign cheques along with the treasurer from October 6th to November 2nd. both days inclusive

Minutes of previous meeting were read, approved and duly signed. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr Hegarty gave notice that at this meeting of Council he would introduce a By Law for the purpose of striking ^{assessment} rates for the year 1945

A request from Frank Scott ^{to the effect} that his relief allowance should be increased by \$5⁰⁰ per month. ^{was granted upon motion} ~~Sec by Mr Hegarty~~ ^{of Mr Ross} ~~that was granted.~~

A bill for killing of sheep by dogs was presented and as the dogs in connection with this killing were known to belong to certain ratepayers of the Township the Clerk was ^{instructed to} notify these parties to destroy their dogs within forty eight hours after receipt of notice.

upon motion of Mr Ross seconded by Mr Hegarty Mr Donald McHann was appointed Tax Collector for the year 1945.

Mr Hegarty then introduced By Law of which he had given notice and upon his motion sec by Mr Ross was given its first reading. On motion of Mr Ross sec by Mr Hegarty By Law #576 was given its second reading and had the following rates inserted
