The clerk was instructed to write our Provincial member of Parliament regarding upkeep of certain bridges within the Township which had been built by the Province.

The resignation of Keith Bulmer as Township Treasurer was received. Upon motion of Ira Byce and Wm Hegarty this was accepted and the Clerk authorized to advertise for a Township Treasurer whose duties would commence on January 1st 1946.
