All members subscribed to the oath of the Court, moved by Mr Hegarty ^{see by Mr Ross that Mr} ~~wasque, act as chairman.~~ ^{Edmund} There were two appeals presented against the assessment of 1946. That of Bronus Wojcik and Ida Byce.

After due consideration the first assessment was sustained and in connection with Mr Byce it was recommended that the part of lot 10 Concession 11. which contains 7 acres be in future assessed in with the remainder of lot 10 Concession 11. at the rate of assessment valuation of main portion of the lot.

Requests from Mrs Laughlin Curry and William Graham for refund of dog tax for 1946 were granted.

Mr Ernest Foss notified the Court of an overcharge in 1945 taxes and a cheque was ~~ordered~~ ^{ordered} to rectify same.
