The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10. A.M.

All members present

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Messrs Walter + Allaw Peener interviewed Council re Road fence.

Hugh Gordon interviewed Council re the paving of County road going through Foresters Falls and <sup>asked</sup> that <sup>they</sup> <sup>should</sup> <sup>frame</sup> a petition <sup>of Parliament</sup> requesting our member Stanley Hunt to bring this before the Minister of Highways Honorable Geo. Howse. In this Council <sup>conferred</sup>.

The proposed granting of a permit to Maurice Sullivan for the erection of a Hotel and the selling of Beer, Wines, and liquors in the Township of Bromley two miles west of Cobden was discussed. It was moved by Fred Ross and Sec by Joseph Bennett that this Council go on record as being opposed to the granting of such a permit and that the Clerk be instructed to mail a copy of this resolution to the liquor Control Board of the Province of Ontario. Carried.
