The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M.

All members present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read adopted and signed by the Secy.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr Wilfred Waite conferred with Council regarding the purchase and price of Township Village lots in F. Falls. Councillor Bennett was delegated to attend to this business.

By Law #583

R.O.A. #552 petitioned Council to grant them a license to operate a Public Hall. It was moved by Mr Ross sec by Mr Bennett that a license be granted upon the payment of a fee of three dollars.

A letter petitioning the Council for a grant to the North Quebec Agriculture Society was dealt with and on motion of Messrs Byce and Hegarty a grant of \$50.00 was made.

On motion of Messrs Bennett and Ross a By Law was passed for the purpose of licensing Public Halls ^{within the Township} and the setting of a ^{minimum} fee of three dollars. carried.
